MARMONTE/CAMINO/CANYON (MCC) FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION GUIDELINES

1. The MCC Football Association is established for football only, and to include the 12 member schools as listed above.
2. The MCC Football Association will include three (3) leagues with four (4) schools placed in each league based on MaxPreps California State football rankings and will function as an association between the 12 member schools as listed above.
3. For the 2014 & 2015 football seasons (2-years), the MCC Football Association will be configured as submitted above.
4. The MCC Football Association will reconfigure for the 2016 & 2017 football season based on the following criteria:
 - a. At the conclusion of the 2015 football season, each school shall be ranked based on their league finish during each of the two football seasons with points awarded commensurate with their league finish (1st place = 1 point...)
 - b. The school with the 2-year highest point total in Marmonte league will move "down" to the Camino league, and the school with the 2-year lowest point total in Camino league will move "up" to the Marmonte league.
 - c. The school with the 2-year highest point total in Camino league will move "down" to the Canyon league, and the school with the 2-year lowest point total in Canyon league will move "up" to the Camino league.
 - d. In case of a tie between two schools the following criteria will be implemented in breaking that tie:
 - i. Head to head competition, over the two year period, will be the first determiner in breaking any tie
 - ii. Head to head competition, during the second season, will be the second determiner in breaking any tie
 - e. In case of a three-way tie the following criteria will be implemented in breaking that tie:
 - i. Head to head competition, over the two year period, will be the first determiner in breaking any tie
 - ii. Head to head competition, during the second season, will be the second determiner in breaking any tie
 - iii. Three-way coin flip will be the final determiner
5. MCC Football Association schools may, by mutual agreement, compete outside of league play though not required to do so.
6. The MCC Football Association schools will meet to adopt a league constitution and discuss all operational issues.
7. Marmonte and Camino will cross-league one contest, home and home agreement, for football only.
